RE: Food Preparation and Nutrition: Non-examination Assessment

I am writing to inform you that your son/daughter has their Food Preparation and Nutrition practical assessment during the week beginning **Monday 11th March.**

The assessments will be taking place on 3 days during this week. Your son/daughter will have been informed which day their assessment will be taking place via Teams. Do ensure that they have checked and are aware of the dates and times of their assessment.

For the assessment your son/daughter will be required to cook, prepare and present 3 dishes of their choice, which meet the requirements of the Non-examination Assessment task set by the Examination Board.

On the day of the assessment your son/daughter will be required to arrive at school at the usual time and register before going to the Food room. There will be 30 minutes preparation time. The assessment is planned to take place between 9 am to 12pm. Once the assessment has been completed, time will be allowed for a break before students return to their lessons.

This assessment forms 35% of the final GCSE grade.

Your son/daughter must be prepared with their time plan and the ingredients that they need for the dishes they have chosen to make. Time will be provided during lessons prior to the assessment to prepare the time plan.
